### BIKE MAINTENANCE

### What Will I Learn?

Discover the different tools and parts of a bike and gain an understanding of how to strip a bike, service a bike and repair a puncture. You may also attend two local primary schools and help deliver short courses to primary 6 and 7 pupils in how to care for their bike. Bike maintenance students spend time travelling in the van collecting bikes from local recycling centres.

The aim is to enable you to develop the skills and knowledge to identify both routine and non-routine maintenance and repair the tasks required on a cycle.
